Dear PCA Curling Club Manager and/or Curling Club President,

The 4 governing bodies in Alberta (SACA - Southern Alberta Curling Association, NACA – Northern Alberta Curling Association, ACF – Alberta Curling Federation, and PCA – Peace Curling Association) are working together to amalgamate this year into a single governing body for curling in Alberta. We have progressed and are pleased to bring this to all society members for vote this spring.

As a PCA affiliated club your members are welcome to attend the meeting, though each club is entitled 2 votes. It is the responsibility of the clubs to appoint their members who will be voting. Attached is the official notice of meeting and the legal package for your review. As a reminder, the SGM is set for June 9th, 1pm at the Grande Prairie Curling Center. Your delegates may vote only in person, and not by proxy as per the PCA bylaws.
